



### **Job Description: Construction Lineman**

The Proline Lineman is experienced in and performs all aspects of aerial and underground communications construction and maintenance. The Lineman position reports directly to the Line-Crew Foreman.

Responsibilities and duties include but are not limited to:

- Experienced with all aspects of new telecommunication installation / construction (copper, coaxial, fiber) for aerial and underground facilities.
- Experienced with communications network maintenance including repairs, preventative maintenance, tree trimming, tree removal, pole transfers, pole removals, wreck-out, etc.).
- Experienced with emergency restoration related to cable cuts, storm damages, contractor damages, etc.
- Experienced and knowledgeable with all vehicles and equipment in use.
- Knowledgeable of pole attachment clearances and separations.
- Complies with all safety, regulatory, OSHA, DOT, Utility, and company requirements.
- Trained on and ensures proper maintenance of vehicles and equipment.
- Tracks and reports time-sheets, inventory, work order changes, performance documentation, vehicle logs, safety logs, field notes, etc.
- Maintains organized and stocked trucks as per work assignments.
- Maintains healthy, positive, and productive work environment.
- Participates in training of ground crew.
- All other duties as required.

Requirements Include:

- Physically able to perform and proficient in the above-mentioned duties, including but not limited to carry and set-up of a 60lb-28ft. ladder and pole climbing to a height of 40 ft.
- Trained and safely able to operate bucket trucks and other construction equipment.
- Understanding of safe set-up and work-zones within and outside of Public Rights of Way.
- Understanding and interpretation of engineering prints, pole attachment walk-sheets, etc.
- Able to work extended periods in all-weather, outdoor environments.
- Ability to travel and stay overnight based upon work assignments.
- Communicates well with crew members and crew foreman.
- Positive / self-motivating working attitude.
- Valid driver's license which meets insurance requirements (CDL license preferred).
- Ability to pass DOT exam and obtain valid medical card.
- Comply with the Drug Free Workforce Act.
- Evening and Weekend "On-Call" schedules.
- Weekend work schedule and overtime may be required.
- Comply with Smoke Free Policy.
